Debbie explained that spaces were filled from the waiting list. We are in need egg cartons for the Jr. Rockhounds, shopping bags for the silent auctions, and VOLUNTEERS to help set up and man tables on the days of the show. Debbie is putting final touches on the show program. Rob talked about the press releases going out soon. Kelli thanked Sylvia for her donation for the grand door prize for our 50th anniversary. Sylvia made a gold ring worth over \$400. Kelli also thanked Don Bush, Nancy Thompson and herself for their donations to the club's fluorescent display.

<u>Librarian</u>- Cole thanked Don and Leslie for their recent donations to the club library. Cole stated the list on the club website needs to be updated with the recent additions.

<u>Historian</u>- Jordan is looking for help preparing the Historical Exhibition for the show, celebrating the clubs 50th Anniversary.

Membership- Larisa had copies of the membership list on each table.

<u>Secretary/correspondence</u>- 3 emails in the last month from people wanting information about rock hounding in the area. One person/family is joining our club.

<u>Field Trip-</u> Thank you Rob and Kathy for last month's trip to Shamrock mine. Saturday's field trip will be to Conata Basin led by the Baileys', sign up and directions on table.

July's field trip we'll be looking for geodes. Location(s) will be announced at the July meeting.

August, September and October field trips are being finalized. We are looking at going to either Vore Buffalo Jump, Beyond Agate Adventures (Nebraska), Dinosaurs of the Hell Creek Museum and Petroglyphs on BLM land. Stay tuned for more on the field trips.

May 30th Show meeting minutes

The meeting started at 3pm and was held at the Nurdy Nuts Expo Hall at the Fairgrounds. Attending meeting were Debbie, Kelli, Leslie, Pete, Lori B., Don and Debra. Ashley from fairgrounds joined us to review building and needs (electric).

Members were shown the GenPro building which is connected to the Nurdy Nuts Expo Hall. This space was offered to us for a discount. Lori and Debra measured the Jr. Rockhounds activity Center and thought it might be too small of space to fit all the activities. Members discussed the possibilities of renting the GenPro building. Lori motioned we rent the GenPro building and Debbie seconded. All were in agreement. Leslie drew up a sketch for the floor plan for the GenPro building, moving the Fluorescent Display, Admission's table, Club info table, Rock ID table, and the show display cases into the building. Entrance for the show is now through the GenPro building. By adding another building and moving several displays and tables creating six more spots for vendors. Debbie will draw up the new floor plan and reach out to vendors who are on the waiting list.

The Friday potluck will now be held in the GenPro building, more room to serve food and sit.

All of the give aways for the Jr Rockhound Activity Center came in and were reviewed.

With the adding of the GenPro building more wall signs are needed. Debra reviewed each display/table and came up with a list of signs to be made.

Meeting adjourned at 4:30pm.

June 28 Final Show Meeting Minutes

Show Chair Debbie Vick called the meeting to order at 10:07am. Attending the meeting were Debbie, Leslie, Pete, John, Larisa, Jason, Don, Debra, Marie, Cole, Rod, Kelli and Jordan.

Debbie gave an update on the floor plan and vendors. All spaces are full. We will have BHI Pete Larson in the Gen Pro building for book signing and Black Hills Prospecting club will set up a static display of their club and gold panning equipment. Pete will be in on Saturday, need to confirm the times. Prospecting club will be there only on Saturday. We are waiting on two contracts; one was lost in mail (MT Agate Shack) the other the vendor is overseas (Keith Lowery) until the end of the month. There are two vendors that we are waiting for their balance payment.

Show cases- Rod stated there are a total of 17 showcases. Three are for the club (Rathert, club and fluorescent). Fourteen cases are used for persons wanting to display their specimens. Seven have been claimed. Seven are still available.

Debra is putting together a power point loop to display pictures of club activities. There is a screen in the Gen Pro building and a power point in the trailer. To give us room for attendees to watch the power point, we will swap the locations of the two club displays and the showcases.

Debbie wanted to know when she should pay the balance for the venue. All were in agreement to pay now. Last year the club got a bill three months after the show for tables and chairs. All were in agreement to write a separate check for \$500 for table and chairs. Last year the bill was about \$575. We expect to be using more tables and chairs this year but we can have a large portion of the bill paid in advance.

Membership/club info- Larisa will be needing cash for change when people purchase a bag or for membership.

Fluorescent display- Jason has the tent poles at his place. He has put it up and taken it down to familiarize himself with the parts. The black plastic for the tent is in the trailer. Kelli has the specimens and will double check the labels. If additional labels are needed, she will tell Debra and she will have Copy Country make them.

Silent Auction- Rob will take over the checkout at the silent auction. He will get the square app downloaded to his phone. Kelli stated she needed more items to auction.

Historian- Jordan showed several posters she made displaying the history of the club. We will need easels to help with all the displays.

Volunteers- Debra passed around the most recent sign-up sheets for volunteers to help with the show. Areas that need coverage are the Jr. Rockhounds and fluorescent display. Since the fluorescent display is close to the club info and rock ID tables, we could have those people help with coverage.

Advertisement- Debra read Rob W email about the advertising status. Rob contacted all media outlet informing them of the incoming press release. KOTA TV said they would likely interview us again. Need to monitor the club emails for radio or TV interviews come in. Reposting flyer on FB with boosting. Reposting flyer on local FB groups that are not rock r elated. Debra had more flyers printed, both 8.5x11 and 5.5x4. Debra had wall signs made. Need additional sign made for Door Prizes.

Friday Potluck- Marie has the potluck app ready to go out next week to all club members. Debra has the plates, cups and plasticware. Need Napkins and additional plates.

Next year show dates- It was decided that next year's show will be July25th and 26th, 2026.

Meeting adjourned at 11:11am.




